

Wild West End House Martin & Swift Survey



Documentation of Incidental Records of Nesting House Martins & Swifts - Summary Instructions for Surveyors

This survey allows all observers to record active house martin and swift nests anywhere within the Wild West End Project area (see map).

If an observer finds nesting house martins or swifts within the Project area (between late April and early September), they record the species and the location of its nest on the Project recording form, completing all requested details; one line for each nest or colony located.

If a colony of nests (i.e. more than one nest) is found count the number of nests and add details under the 'Other Notes' column of the Recording Form.

The location of the nest (or colony) should also be marked on the map, which is provided (if possible, use different colours for nests recorded on different dates, or 'date' each nest recorded).

Due care should be paid to maintaining surveyor safety at all times.

At the end of the season, the recording form and maps should be returned to the Project coordinator.
